"Mine and Two More"

All MGA members should be following the "mine and two more policy". Pitch marks on greens and divots in fairways do not repair themselves. When you repair your pitch mark on the green, look around and repair two others. If your ball did not make a pitch mark, repair two pitch marks which weren't repaired by inconsiderate players. Each time you hit a ball from the fairway (or rough) repair your divot and find two others to repair. Be stewards of the course. Lead by example.

hanksgiving is right around the corner, and more often than not, it's the time of year that weight tends to fluctuate and healthy habits are kicked to the curb! Holiday season is the toughest time of the year to stay on track with your Fitness Goals because everything is centered on food...and LOTS of it! Here are five tips and tricks to help you stay on track through the Holidays!

- **1.** Fit it all on one plate. Prevent over-stuffing yourself by fitting your Thanksgiving feast all on one plate (This works best if you don't use an oversized plate filled to the brim). Sample small portions and avoid going back for seconds. If you're tempted to return for more, give yourself 20 minutes (about how long it takes to feel full) first.
- **2.** Eat slowly. Thanksgiving foods are likely to be richer and more filling than your everyday fare, so eat slowly and savor every bite.
- **3.** Enjoy the company of family and friends. Socialize during your meal and festivities. You can't eat and talk at the same time ~ so the more conversation you enjoy, the less you'll eat.
- **4.** Get moving. Sign up for a local Turkey Trot 5K or 10K and spend your Thanksgiving morning getting some exercise. Not only will you burn some calories, but you'll also enjoy some holiday fun!
 - **5.** Make some easy Turkey day substitutions. For example:
 - Eat the white meat without the skin instead of the dark meat with skin and shave off 190 calories.

Turkey – white meat, no skin (6oz): 180 calories, 3g fat **Turkey** - dark meat, with skin (6oz): 370 calories, 20g fat







DID YOU KNOW?

Waterside Grill

With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage.

In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.
