ATTENTION MEMBERS:

I would also like to remind everyone that the golf course is typically closed on Mondays (unless we have a special event or holiday), and we ask all members to refrain from using the course or driving range when we are closed. The Golf Course is for golfing only. (No bicycling, jogging, skateboarding, roller-blading, motorcycle's unauthorized carts, walking dogs etc.). On Mondays the golf course is closed and there should not be any unauthorized activity on the golf course. No ATVs or non-approved golf carts permitted on the course or golf cart paths at anytime.

We are asking for your assistance in repairing ball marks, divots and staying the proper distance away from the green. Please observe the 90-degree golf cart rule along with not driving the carts any closer than 30 yards to the green, as well as staying on the cart path when posted.

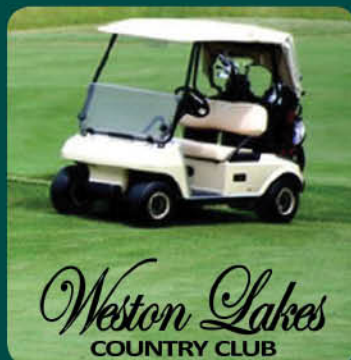

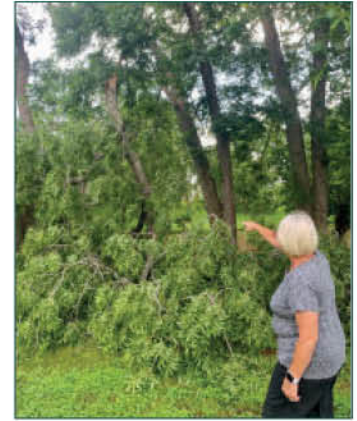

With the Great Freeze, the Never Ending Spring Rain, and an Epic Plague of Mosquitoes, the wonderful folks of Weston Lakes continue to prove that we can roll with the punches!! The POA Board has made every effort to stay on top of things.

The rains and wind brought down trees and limbs in our parks and public areas that required cutting and removal of nine trees to manage risk and keep our spaces looking good!

Mosquito spraying in all of our neighborhoods, including Waterford and the Reserve, began in the spring and will continue on a weekly basis throughout the season. It is impossible to eliminate all mosquitoes, but spraying is intended to temporarily reduce the numbers.

The lightning storm took a toll on our gate systems. An EZ tag reader and other electrical equipment had to be replaced, and there was a backlog for certified contractors who do repairs. Thank you for your patience as challenges such as these are addressed as quickly as possible. Two radar speed signs also had to be sent in for repairs.



Great news for the many residents who enjoy Riverwood Park. We will be offering FREE Wi-Fi connection near the basketball courts! Network and password information will be provided. If you have an AT&T internet account, you can also log in under your account. Cameras are up and working in the park to provide added security.

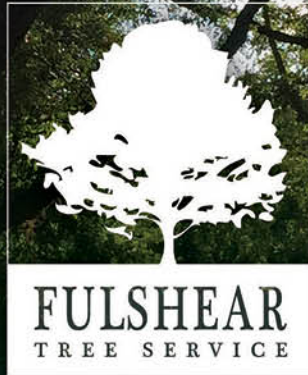

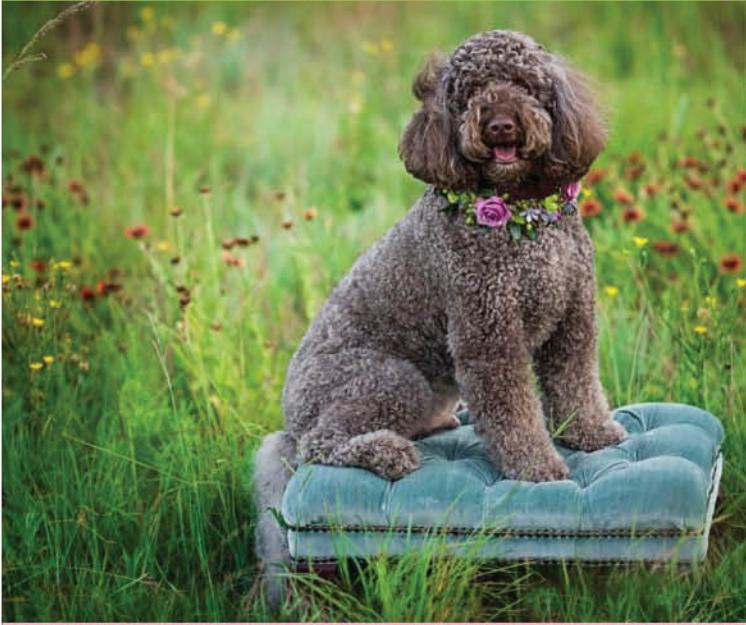

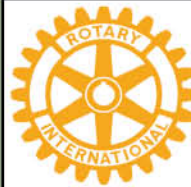
