

Continue to keep our SMGA members battling health issues in your prayers.



KWLB Neighborhood Bird Sanctuary. Plans for the Bird Sanctuary are moving rapidly now! With the generous sponsorship of residents and local businesses, the funding to complete the initial project is at about 75 percent of the total needed. Sponsorships are still available and donations of any size are always welcome! A few raffle tickets for the hand crafted Cypress wood bench are still available.

Governors Award Trees Update. The almost 200 new trees and shrubs planted last fall at the entrance to Weston Lakes are looking good in spite of an exceptionally hot and dry summer. This major project was a result of KWLB winning the Governors Community Achievement Award, sponsored by Keep Texas Beautiful and TxDOT, in 2019. The landscape company, Yellowstone, who was contracted by TxDOT for the project, has been monitoring the irrigation of the trees and will replace any trees that die within a year.







If you could play anywhere that you have not, where would that be? A bucket list course I would like to play is none other than St. Andrews Old Course in Scotland. One of the oldest in the world and where many legends have played.

Who is your favorite professional golfer?

My favorite professional golfer is Toni Finau. I have been following him for years. Respect the way he carries himself on and off the course. So happy to see him playing to his potential with two recent PGA wins.

Do you have a favorite golf club in your bag and what is it? Golf Balls? The go-to club in my bag is a Callaway 5 wood. Current golf balls that I use are Vice.

How many hole-in-ones have you had?

I have had two holes-in-one. First was on #13 at Weston Lakes. A few months later at La Cantera in San Antonio, I got my second hole-in-one after sculling the ball off the tee box. Oh well, still counts.

What do you like to do when you are not golfing? Do you have a hobby? Hobbies? You mean there are other things to do besides golf? I love golf that much. I do like to run and work out. I have completed over 20 half marathons, 6 full marathons, 2 Dopey Challenges at Disney, and 1 Tough Mudder.

Is there something you could tell us about yourself that would be interesting to know? You met someone famous?

An interesting fact about myself is that I once created an app that received national attention. I have met and appeared on the Steve Harvey show because of the app. Appeared remotely on other shows such as Today Show, Good Morning American, Closing Bell, and NBC Nightly News.

DID YOU KNOW?

With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage.

In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are pald an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.


