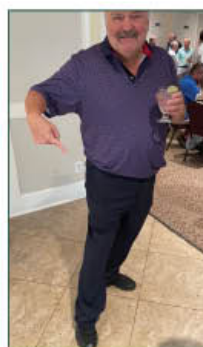

K **WLB Neighborhood Bird Sanctuary.** October 11th was a BIG DAY for KWLB and Weston Lakes! Twenty-eight volunteers assisted our contractor, Aqua-Springs, with the building of the water feature for the Bird Sanctuary in the Weston Lakes Nature Reserve. The water feature is technically called a disappearing waterfall, but it looks much like a babbling stream found in nature that will provide water for the birds to drink and bathe!



The initial excavation of the stream basin was started the day before. Large moss rocks, river rock, and pebbles had been delivered earlier. We had a fantastic turnout of hard working volunteers that included WL residents, Texas Master Naturalists from the Coastal Prairie Chapter, and the KWLB Board. This group toted rocks, hauled pebbles, tugged liner, filled in soil, and had fun. Planting the tribute trees, small trees, shrubs, and

other native plants will enhance the beauty of the water feature, as well as provide food and shelter for the birds.

The day after the installation, I sat in the shade of the pecan trees near the water feature. Within 45 minutes I observed 10 different species of birds (Yellow-bellied Sapsucker, Red-bellied Woodpecker, Downy Woodpecker, Eastern Phoebe, Blue Jay, American Crows, Carolina Chickadees, Tufted Titmouse, Eastern Bluebirds, and Northern Cardinals). KWLB sends profound thanks to everyone who has sponsored, donated, volunteered, and cheered on this project. We can't wait to see residents enjoying the birds while listening to the peaceful sound of the running stream

Leaves are falling... and prices for everything are going up! Fall is budget time for the POA Board. The board worked long and diligently to review expenses for the year and comparison to budget. We also researched anticipated price increases for 2023 for the goods and services required to maintain our community and protect our property values. The 2023 budget was prepared and presented at the October POA meeting.

Property Owners Association Expense Examples

- **Entrance and exit gates** - Five gates for restricted access entrance and/or exit. Two are manned (personnel costs) and all have technology/equipment to manage access that require upgrades and maintenance. Good news ~ the new generator for the gate at The Reserve is in and fully functional.
- **86 concrete streets, four bridges, and entrances** into neighborhood sections, street and traffic signs ~ maintenance and replacement costs.
- **Four neighborhood parks** ~ Riverwood, Pecan, Lake Village, and Brazos River ~ upkeep, replacement of aged playground equipment, addition of amenities such as pickle ball courts. New playground equipment for Riverwood is on its way!
- **Two neighborhood lakes** ~ Oxbow and Pecan ~ herbicide application and dredging as needed
- **Management Company contract**
- **Legal Expenses**
..... and more.



Thanksgiving Holiday. Did you know that Thanksgiving Day is the biggest day of the year for family and friends coming in to Weston Lakes? To expedite entry through the gate and avoid guests missing the first course of Thanksgiving dinner, you will once again be able to request a "Pre-Authorized Thanksgiving Day "Special" Gate Pass for all expected guests to use for entry. The details for requesting the pass and how it works will be emailed from Weston Lakes POA in early November with another reminder in mid-November. Be on the lookout for the these emails.

Auto Attendant. One of the three ways residents can announce a guest at the main entrance or The Reserve entrance is by calling the Auto Attendant system and leaving a voice mail message for the gate attendant. A new telephone number is now in service along with an upgraded system. The new telephone number is **844-966-40470**. The two previous numbers will remain active for a time period to ease the transition, but will be disconnected in the near future. The **Gatehouse App**, which is a very convenient easy way to add visitors and vendors, continues to be available.
