GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

CIP Update

The cart path work is coming along very well except for a few rain delays. Despite the delays, we are over half-way complete. Additional work will include resodding some areas that need to be restored from the work that was done. We will also start grooming the greens to promote the growth of the Bermuda grass and to eliminate the winter grass.

Doing your part:

There are a few other things to keep in mind while raking that can help maintain the bunker and surrounding grass areas:

- Always enter and exit on the low side of a bunker – do not jump down or climb up steep faces, even if it might be a faster. . .
- Before exiting the bunker, please rake the bunker, and remember to use the flat part of the rake in the bottom of the bunker.
- Divots - Chances are, if you've hit a good shot, you will have taken a divot out of the ground. Replacing your divots is a fundamental of good golf etiquette; you always want to do your best to leave the course the way you found it. Doing this shows that you care about keeping the golf course in good shape and helps maintain the golf course. Golf carts have sand bottles to help fill in your divot, and it's imperative you do so.

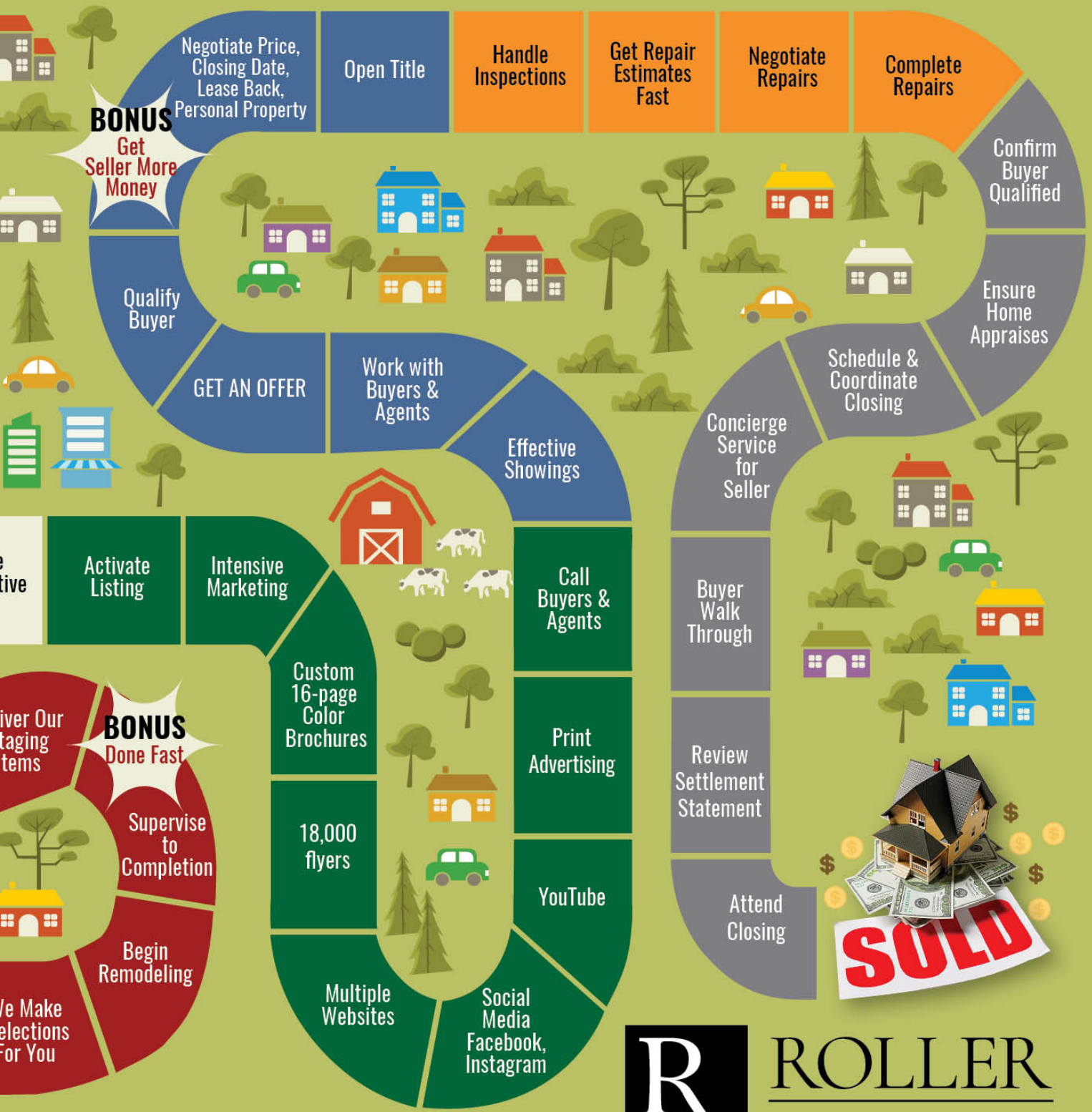

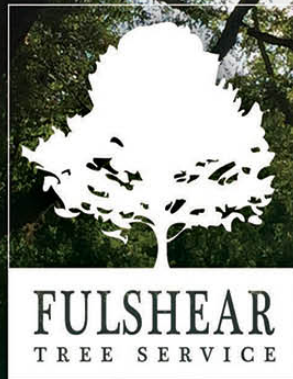

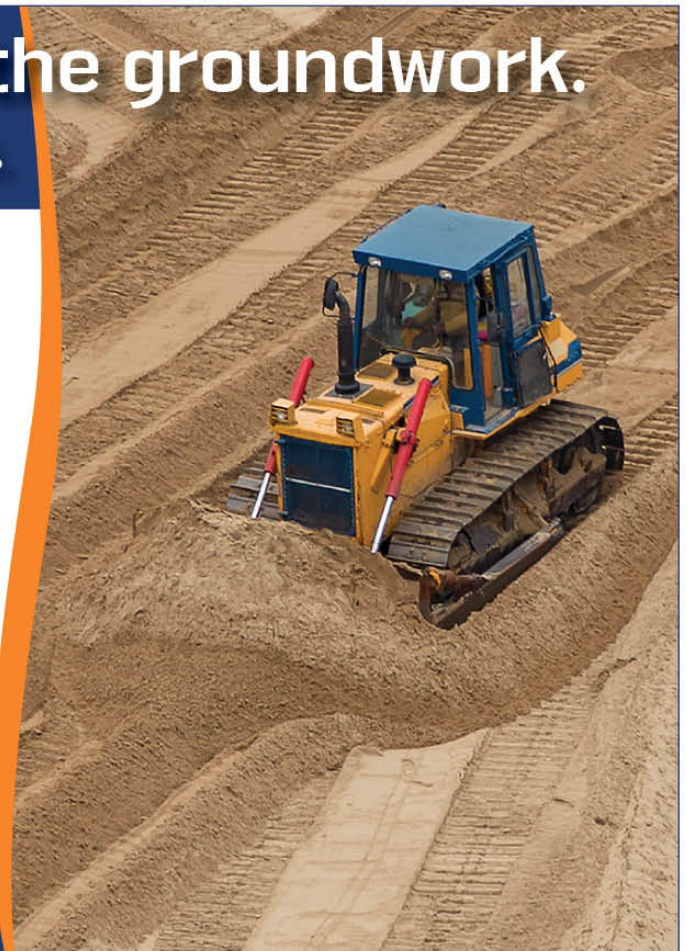
