### Renovation Update:

I'm excited about the progress made over the last several years and the progress we will continue to make in the next five years. Several years ago, WLCC embarked on an approximately \$8,000,000 CIP program. Phase 1 & 2 have been completed with the development of a new Pro Shop, Fitness Center, 19<sup>th</sup> hole and Weston Room. We also upgraded the irrigation system for the golf course along with construction of the 716 Bunker Concession on the golf course. The opening of the new Weston Lakes CC Recreational complex, which includes 4 tennis courts, an 8-lane competition pool, a splash pad for the kids, a pavilion for restrooms and concession. The bunker renovations are complete and are in play now. While still a lot of work to go, we have begun the repair and replacement plan for the original golf paths, along with replacing and upgrading all course signage and markers.

Phase 3 is currently planned over the next year to 5 years. It will include:

- 1) Expansion of club parking lot
- 2) Upgrade of existing family pool and restrooms and convert to adult pool
- 3) Development of outdoor entertainment venue in adult pool area
- 4) Continued renovation and replacement of golf course cart paths

There are still many investments and improvements to be made. We will continue to invest available dollars in the upcoming years as we move to replace aging infrastructure and equipment. Some spending examples include HVAC units, fire alarm systems, kitchen equipment, maintenance equipment, facility updates, etc. We appreciate your patience while we are under construction on these projects. Our collective work aims to continue to grow our membership, improve our financial position, and make Weston Lakes Country Club the place we choose to spend time with friends and our families! I look forward to a fun, enjoyable, and successful year with everyone at Weston Lakes Country Club!

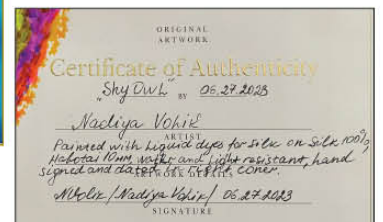

### DID YOU KNOW?

With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage. In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.
