- Scarlet sage (*Salvia coccinea*). Flowers much of the year and reseeds itself;
- Indian blanket (*Gaillardia pulchella*). Great, bright bloomer. Reseeds itself;
- Gulf muhly (*Muhlenbergia capillaries*). A perennial grass only 2-3 feet tall with stunning pink seed heads in autumn.

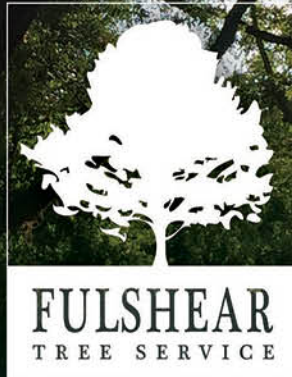

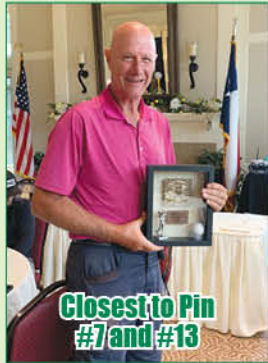
